- 01/04/10 Dallastown Recreation Board Meeting was not scheduled for this date due to the Council Reorganization Meeting which had to occur on the 1st Monday of January. The next Recreation Board Meeting will occur on the regularly scheduled 3rd Monday of January.
- 01/04/10 Attended Dallastown Council Reorganization Meeting and regular Council Meeting.
- 01/04/10 Administered Oath of Office to recently elected Dallastown Council Members and Tax Collector.
- 01/07/10 Dallastown Area Historical Society Reorganization Meeting. Did not attend – instead attended Birthday Party for Tracy Hoyt, brother of Recreation Board Member, Karen Hoyt-Stewart, and former Council Member, Bill Stewart. I was elected to remain as Treasurer for the Society.
