

Dallastown Borough Recreation Board

Minutes – Monday, March 1, 2010

MEMBERS PRESENT: President Priscilla Gill, Vice-President Karen Hoyt-Stewart, Scott Shaffer, Carol Rebuck, Mayor Beverly Scott, Lisa Meyers-Naill, and Secretary Theresa A. Craley.

Approval of Minutes:
