

Dallastown Borough Recreation Board

Minutes – Monday, April 19, 2010

MEMBERS PRESENT: President Priscilla Gill, Vice-President Karen Hoyt-Stewart, Scott Shaffer, Carol Rebuck, Mayor Beverly Scott, and Secretary Theresa A. Craley.

GUESTS PRESENT: Jack Gerver from York Area Church Softball League and Jason Winand from Dallastown Cougar Baseball.

The meeting was called to order by President Priscilla Gill at 7:06 p.m.

Approval of Minutes:

Motion to approve the minutes of April 5, 2010 Recreation Board meeting was made by Scott Shaffer and seconded by Carol Rebuck. All were in favor.

Approval of Payment of Bills:

There were no bills presented for payment.

Approval of Financial Statement:

There was no Financial Statement presented for approval.

Visitor Input:

Jason Winand from Dallastown Cougar Baseball reported that the Cougars are taking care of two spots where the dirt was put and they will be reseeding it. The board asked if both fields could be used at the same time. Jason said that both fields could be used for the 13 years of age and under, or one field if it is being used for the 13 and older team. There was a mound issue, however, it was solved. There is a parking issue on Cherry Lane and Jason said he would take care of letting these parents know about the no parking on Cherry Lane. If they park there, they will get a ticket. Jason asked what the board thought about the possibility of putting four more lights up at the park to play later. The lights that are currently there are not high enough and should be another fifteen feet higher. Jason was asked to gather information about the cost of these lights and the cost of their installation along with a cost to adjust the other two lights to fifteen feet. He said that he would look into it and get back to us at our next meeting in May. He also suggested that the Borough could look into obtaining a grant to purchase and install these lights. Theresa A. Craley suggested that the York Area Council of Governments might be able to write a letter of support for this grant. There is a fence that is falling down. It

was agreed to tell our maintenance department about this issue. Jason also asked about the blue bench that is twisted. Karen told him that we have the parts and it will be fixed soon. The pavilion list was passed around.

Correspondence: Karen told the board that she had received two more yard sale applications. The carnival contract from BJ Concessions was received as well.

Business for Action:

Dog Walk Fundraiser Event – May 1 – Scott reported that the one mile loop and the 2 mile loop are already planned out. There will be water stops. Priscilla Gill agreed to talk to Manor Care in Dallastown to see if they would participate and be one of the stops. Beverly Scott agreed to contact Exxon to see if they would participate and be the other stop. At the Exxon, Scott would like to see a table and have the use of the bathrooms. The event is May 1st, 2010 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Karen agreed to get the 20 portable yellow “No Parking Signs”.

Yard Sale – May 15 – Beverly Scott & Lisa Meyers-Naill Karen said that she has received several paid applications. Karen and Theresa will set up for the event on Friday, May 14th.

Family Fun Day – June 5 – Priscilla Gill, Beverly Scott & Theresa A. Craley
The committee will meet prior to our next board meeting and report on their progress. Karen has purchased bracelets for this event. Hula Hoops were discussed. Priscilla will be doing the bean bag game. Karen purchased items from Oriental Trading for the gifts. One game could be the milk bottle jars and rings.

Business for Discussion:

Red Lion Street Fair – August 7th – The event is really on August 14th as the date was changed. Beverly Scott had sent 3 e-mails to the person in charge of this event in Red Lion to discuss the increase in the amount we had to pay to participate in this event. It was \$50.00 for years and now they are charging \$125.00. When she finally talked to Ryan Sanders, she was told that this has been the fee for several years, however, Dallastown Borough was only charged \$50.00. He said that this is the fee for us this year. Since they changed the event to August 14th, we decided not to participate since this is the day we set up for our carnival.

Carnival – 8/17 to 8/21 – Karen agreed to prepare the business donation letters. There are no signed contracts as of this meeting for either Full Tilt or Jackson. Beverly agreed to contact the vendors from the past years. Karen will look into getting tickets for a dinner theater. She has already purchased tickets for NASCAR in the amount of \$187.00. These NASCAR tickets are part of a package and are for a race to be held on September 25th, 2010.
