Approval of Minutes:

Business for Action:

Family Fun Day – June 5 – Priscilla Gill, Beverly Scott & Theresa A. Craley

Karen gave an update on the event we had last Saturday. She said that it was a great day and that we served over 186 hot dogs, pickles, chips, nachos and nacho cheese, and lost of hamburger barbeque. Everyone had a great time and many residents came to enjoy the day with us. The art tent was a great idea and the freezing of the ice tea and lemonade prior to the event worked out extremely well. The balloon animals and face painting were a hit. Maybe not having as much Manwich would be better next year. The kids loved the fire truck rides and the police identification cards. Brian from Giant was really great and went above and beyond. Some suggestions for changes for next year were: An additional box of nachos and an additional can of nacho cheese; have a Bounce; have a petting zoo, have shaved ice; possibly have veggies or fruit; maybe have Chili Dilly. It was agreed to set Saturday, June 4, 2011 as the date for next year's event.

Business for Discussion:

Scott reported that he met with the man who is going to install the fence for the dog park. He said that they have enough fence to complete the park. The gentleman who is installing the fence will be donating the entrance section as well as some other pieces. Scott has called to get this project started, however, he has not heard from him yet.

Camping at the Park – June 26, July 10, and September 11 – Everyone wanted to camp on these dates will need to pre-register. Karen said that he would contact one of the Boy Scout troops to help out with this event. Each camp out will have a theme.

National Night Out – August 3 – This event will be taken care of by Officer Montgomery. We will be there to help out that evening.

Carnival – August 17 to August 21 – Karen has received several contracts so far and will write to each of these to inform them that we will let them know by July 1st the food that they will be able to sell at the Carnival. The purpose for this is so that everyone will be selling a variety of food items. Applications for the Dallastown's Got Talent event are coming in extremely slow. Everyone discussed opening up the event to others outside of

Dallastown. It was agreed that we will wait for a week or two since school is out at the end of this week. Theresa agreed to send out the flyer to several people that she knows.
