ENGINEER'S REPORT

The Engineer's report was given by the Borough Engineer Steve Malesker.

- The 2025 Sewer Maintenance Program was awarded to Mr. Rehab. Mr. Rehab will begin work on June 16, 2025.
- The Colonial Heights sewer extension project is coming along. Act 537 was submitted on March 26th. A planning consultation was held with PENNVEST on March 31st. The Water Quality Management Permit Application was submitted on April 11th. Mr. Malesker is waiting for the Act 537 and WQM approvals. He is hoping to have the permits soon, which will allow for a PENNVEST submission in August.
- Barrasso Excavation should be finishing up the CDBG project on W. Chestnut St. and W. Broad Street. Mr. Malesker stated a final walk through is going to be scheduled.
