- HRG submitted the DEP Water Supply Permit Amendment needed for the Hardees Interconnect. We are now
  waiting for the CFA Grant award announcements. The electrical and communications components of the
  metering station are the only remaining items to finalize the design. HRG will have their electrical engineers
  assist in the design.
- The DEP Public Water Supply Permit Amendment needed to install mixers at the Park St. tank is under review by DEP. Mr. Medinsky will continue to update Mrs. Stokes and DYWA on the status of the permit.
- HRG has utilized the GIS information in CSDatum, and the data available thru DYWA's SCADA system, to start building the Hydraulic Model of the water system. Mr. Mendinsky will continue to gather more information from Mr. Joines and Borough staff as needed.
- Inch & Co. is looking to sub-divide/develop land at 70 S. Franklin St. These homes would be serviced by Dallastown Yoe Water Authority. This is in the beginning phase and there will be more information to come later.

#### **SOLICITOR'S REPORT**

• Mr. Ruth has no updates regarding T-Mobile and paying for the damages to the Lions Park Tank.

### **MANAGER'S REPORT**

- Tank levels have been good.
- Mrs. Stokes would like to replace the water main on S. Wilson Ct., in Yoe. Mr. Malesker recommended checking
  with Yoe Borough to see if they would like to jointly apply through CDBG. As of right now the cost estimate from
  Kinsley is around \$150,000.
