UPDATE ON TREATMENT PLANT

- New treatment plant is running smooth. The Antenna was installed on the roof for SCADA, signal is very good and there is no need to cut down any trees to make the signal stronger.
- There are several types of grass growing in reservoir. RLMA is having an outside independent company come in to do a study of the plant life in the reservoir to determine what species of plants are growing and the best way to control the problem, whether it be grass carp or herbicides. So far it has not caused any major problems but it needs to get under control before it does.

PROJECTED UPGRADES AND OTHER PROJECTS

- DYWA completed replacing the water main on E. Main St. and Penn Dot is getting ready to pave Main St.
- DWYA is working on bids to take down the 2 Park St. tanks and replacing them with 1 larger 750,000 gallon composite tank. Bids will be awarded once financing is finalized, this project will take place in 2020-2021. They will also be raising the Denton St. tank in 2021.
- RLMA just completed a project at Burrows Lane to add a second connection back to the apartment buildings and behind Lion's Pride and to Dairyland Square.

RLMA is also looking to replace the main down Springdale Road 2020-2021.

COMMUNICATIONS

- Communication between DYWA & RLMA has been good.
- RLMA had an incident with lightening a few months ago. One of the flow meter transmitters was hit by lightning that came thru the main. They do have replacement boxes ready to go for these incidents and the repair was made quickly and everything was back to normal.

OTHER BUSINESS FOR ACTION/DISCUSSION

There was no other business for action.

DYWA INTERCONNECT WITH YORK WATER

Attorney Ruth, Mrs. Stokes and Mr. Joines are working with DEP and York Water to finalize the
Emergency Connection Agreement between Dallastown-Yoe Water and York Water. The next step is a
meeting with DEP to find out how much water DWY must use on a monthly/annual basis thru the
interconnect. York Water did start extending their main without any permits or ok from DWYA, they will
not make any connections until DWYA speaks to DEP.

DALLASTOWN-YOE WATER AUTHORITY RED LION MUNICIPAL AUTHORTIY CONTRACT

 DYWA received the new contract and it will be reviewed at the August meeting. RLMA members agreed to meet and discuss any questions if needed.
